JUDGMENT WITHOUT OPINION

Decided November 22, 1984.

When this case was called for hearing, Counsellor H. Varney Sherman appeared for the appellee and gave notice that he had filed a motion to dismiss the appeal for failure on the part of appellant to proceed, citing Rev. Code 1 :51.16. Counsellor J. Emmanuel Berry appeared for the appellant and conceded the legal soundness of the motion for which he interposed no resistance.
