At the call of this case, Counsellor Lawrence R. Johnson appeared for appellant and

Counsellor Cyril Jones of the Jones & Jones Law Firm appeared for appellees.

Counsel for both appellant and appellees brought to the attention of the Court that

they have jointly filed a notice of withdrawal, relevant portion of which reads thus:

"...that the petitioner/appellant and the respondents/ appellees in the above entitled

cause of action hereby withdraw all their claims and or defenses in the above

mentioned summary proceedings."

After carefully studying the said notice of withdrawal and applying the controlling

law, it is hereby adjudged that the appeal which had given this Court jurisdiction over

the case having been withdrawn said appeal is hereby ordered stricken from the
