JUDGMENT WITHOUT OPINION

At the call of this case for argument, Counsellor Daniel Draper of the Philip J. L. Brumskine Law Chambers, announced representation for the appellee and Counsellor J. Emmanuel Wureh announced representation for the appellant. Following these announcements, the counsel for appellee called the Court's attention to a motion which the appellee had filed to dismiss the appeal for failure to proceed.
