## JUDGMENT WITHOUT OPINION

At the call of this case for hearing, Counsellor Parlee Kwekeh of the Cooper and Togbah Law Firm appeared for the Agricultural Cooperative & Development Bank (ACDB) by and thru its President of the City of Monrovia and reminded the court that they have filed a two-count motion to dismiss the appeal, in that, besides the filing of the bill of exceptions, the respondents have failed and neglected to perfect the appeal.

The respondents were represented by Counsellor Snonsio E. Nigba who then made the following record: "At this stage, counsel for respondents, Counselor Snonsio E. Nigba says that because of the legal soundness of the movant's motion to dismiss the appellant's appeal, he therefore concedes all of the legal points raised therein the said motion. And respectfully submits." After carefully studying the motion to dismiss the appeal and the concession of the respondent's counsel, it is hereby adjudged that this court has no alternative but to dismiss the appeal. The appeal is therefore dismissed with costs against the respondents. The Clerk of this Court is hereby instructed to send a mandate to the National Labour Court ordering the judge presiding therein to resume jurisdiction and enforce its judgment. And it is hereby so ordered.
