JUDGMENT WITHOUT OPINION

Decided January 23, 1987.

When this case was called for hearing, the Bull Law Firm, represented by Counsellor Pearl Bull, appeared for the appellee/movant; no one appeared for the appellant/respondent. Counsel for appellee brought to the Court's attention that appellee had filed a motion to dismiss the appellant's appeal, a copy of which was served on appellant. Counsel also averred that even though a notice of assignment was served and returned served on both parties, counsel for appellant had failed and neglected to appear. Appellee therefore prayed for the granting of the motion.
