JUDGMENT WITHOUT OPINION.

At the call of this case Counsellor *Joseph Williamson* appeared for the petitioner, and Counsellor *Toye* C. Bernard appeared for respondents and filed notice of withdrawal of the appeal they had announced from the ruling of the Justice in chambers. It is therefore adjudged that the notice of withdrawal should be and the same is hereby granted with costs against respondents. And the Clerk of this Court is ordered to send a mandate down to the court below commanding the judge presiding therein to resume jurisdiction over the cancellation proceedings out of which these prohibition proceedings have grown, and to have the parties return to *status quo ante*, or to the position they were in respectively before the issuance of the writ of possession, and thus remain until the motion to vacate a void judgment has been fully determined. And it is so ordered.
