JUDGMENT WITHOUT OPINION

When this case was called for hearing, Counsellor James Kandakai and Counsellor M. Fahnbulleh Jones appeared for the appellee and filed a motion to dismiss the appeal for failure of the appellant to proceed in that no appeal bond and no notice of the completion of appeal were filed to give this Court jurisdiction over the case. Although Counsellor Emmanuel Berry signed the notice of assignment as representing the appellant, no one appeared for the said appellant at the call of the case. After studying the motion, and in keeping with Rule of Court, it is adjudged that the motion to dismiss should be and the same is hereby granted and the appeal is dismissed with costs against the appellant. The Clerk of this Court is ordered to send a mandate to the trial court commanding the judge presiding therein to resume jurisdiction and enforce the judgment. And it is so ordered.
