The above-entitled cause was on appeal from the Chambers of Mr. Justice Barclay. When the case was bulletined for hearing and before this Court could review the records certified to it, the counsel for petitioners for the writ of prohibition filed in the office of the clerk of this Court a formal application for withdrawal of the petition dated November 26, 1943, which stated the following:
