JUDGEMENT WITHOUT OPINION

When this case was called for hearing, Counsellor A. Kanie, Wesso appeared for Petitioner/Appellant. No Counsel appeared Respondents/Appellees.

Counsel for Petitioner/Appellant, Counsellor A. Kanie Wesso, requested permission from the Court to make a submission following representation, which request was granted. In his submission, Petitioner/Appellant's Counsel informed this Court that his Client, Shiek K. M. Sackor, has since been released from prison and is presently out of the Country.
