

JALLAH B. SANDY, Appellant, v. **REPUBLIC OF LIBERIA**, Appellee

JUDGMENT WITHOUT OPINION

Decided: February 4, 1982.

When this case was called for hearing, no one appeared for the appellant. The Solicitor General, Counsellor Jimmie S. Geizue of the Republic of Liberia appeared for the appellee and gave notice of abandonment of further prosecution of this case because of insufficiency of evidence to prosecute said case.
