JUDGMENT WITHOUT OPINION

At the call of this case, Counsellor Wade Appleton appeared for the appellant, and Counsellor Clarence Harmon appeared for the appellee and filed motion to dismiss the appeal as announced on the ground that this Court lacks jurisdiction over the case because no appeal bond was filed and no notice of completion of appeal was prepared and served on the appellee. After considering the motion and hearing argument of counsel, it is adjudged that the motion should be and the same is hereby granted, and the appeal dismissed with costs against the appellant. And the Clerk of this Court is ordered to send a mandate down to the lower court commanding the judge therein to resume jurisdiction over the case and enforce the judgment. And it is so ordered.
