### JUDGMENT WITHOUT OPINION

At the call of this case, Counsellors M. Kron Yangbe and J. Emmanuel Wureh appeared for the plaintiff-in-error and Counsellor N. Oswald Tweh of the Pierre, Tweh & Associates appeared for defendants-in-error. Counsel for plaintiff-in-error informed the Court that his client had filed a submission to withdraw its case, to which there was no resistance made by the defendants-in-error.
