## JUDGMENT WITHOUT OPINION

When this case was called for hearing, Counsellor Denise S. Sokan of the Jones & Jones Law Firm appeared for the appellant. Counsellors James N. Kumeh and Samuel Pearson, In-House Legal Counsels of the Monrovia City Corporation, appeared for the appellee.

At the call of the case Counsel for appellant made the following submission:

"Counsel for appellant begs to inform Your Honors that the parties have met and agreed to have the matter settle[d] out of court, and hence they have filed a

Notice of Voluntary Discontinuance of the matter, which has been approved by one of the Justices of the Honorable Supreme Court. And respectfully submits".

An inspection of the records revealed that on November 10, 2016, the Counsels for the respective parties filed with the Clerk of this Court, a joint Notice of Voluntary Discontinuance which reads:

"NOTICE OF VOLUNTARY WITHDRAWAL The Clerk The Honorable Supreme Court of Liberia Temple of Justice Monrovia, Liberia

The Honorable Clerk:

Please take note and spread on the records of this Honorable Court that the above entitled cause of action was filed on the 1st day of July A.D. 2016.

Moreover, on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of May, A.D. 2016, an appeal was taken by the Appellant/Respondent in the above entitled cause of action, which process has been completed thereby giving the Honorable Court jurisdiction over the subject matter.

However, the parties have agreed to voluntarily discontinue this cause of action before the Honorable Supreme Court on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of August A.D. 2016 without reservation. In furtherance thereof, the parties herein have mutually agreed and executed on August 1<sup>st</sup> 2016 a Service Contract, therefore they are requesting the Court below to surrender to their legal Counsels all monies received from the parties therein, their clients directly and indirectly and kept in Escrow Account by the Sheriff of the Court below to be submitted to the Counsels on both sides.

AND FOR SO DOING THIS SHALL CONSTITUTE YOUR SUFFICIENT AND LEGAL AUTHORITY.
