JUDGMENT WITHOUT OPINION.

When this case was called no one appeared for the appellant. Counsellor Richard A. Diggs appeared for the appellee and filed a motion to dismiss the appeal on the ground that although judgment was rendered in the Debt Court in Cape Palmas on November 7, 1972, up to the time of filing of his motion on September 25, 1973, no appeal bond nor notice of completion of appeal had been filed as the law requires. After considering the motion, it is adjudged that the motion to dismiss the appeal be and the same is hereby granted and the appeal is dismissed with costs against the appellant. And the Clerk of this Court is ordered to send a mandate to the court below commanding the judge to resume jurisdiction and enforce the judgment. And it is so ordered.
