JUDGMENT WITHOUT OPINION.

When this case was called, Counsellor *Daniel Draper* appeared for the appellant, and Counsellor *Edward N. Wollor* appeared for the appellees and filed a motion to dismiss the appeal on the ground of appellant's failure to file an approved appeal bond. Appellant's counsel conceding the merit of the motion, made no resistance thereto. It is therefore adjudged that the motion to dismiss should be and the same is hereby granted and the appeal is dismissed with costs against the appellant. And the Clerk of this Court is ordered to send a mandate to the lower court commanding the judge therein to resume jurisdiction over the cause and enforce the judgment. And it is so ordered.
