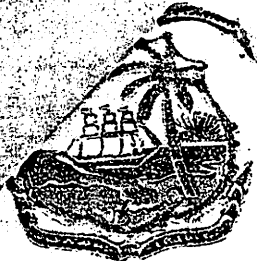
JUDGMENT WITHOUT OPINION

When this case was called for hearing, Counsellor Peter W. Howard of Barbu, Howard and Associates, Inc., appeared for the movants/appellees. Counsellor D. Anthony Mason of the Henries Law Firm appeared for the respondent/appellant.

Following the Court's notation of representation by the parties, counsel for the movant, with leave of Court, made a submission informing the Court that the respondent/appellant neglected and failed to file the Appeal Bond and serve and file the Notice of Completion of the Appeal, thereby rendering the respondent/appellant's appeal dismissible. Counsel for respondent/appellant conceded to the soundness of the factual and legal grounds of the motion to dismiss the appeal.

This Court notes that perusal of the certified records before us supports the averments made by counsel for the movant/appellee as well as the concession of the respondent/appellant's counsel. It is a well-established principle of law in this jurisdiction that a motion to dismiss an appeal is tenable where the appellant, as in this case, failed to complete the appeal process.

Accordingly, and in view of the foregoing, it is hereby
