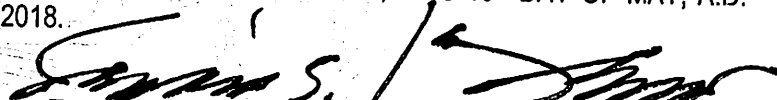
To this submission, the counsels for the movant/appellee interposed no objection.

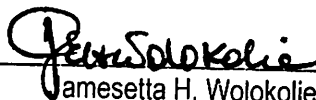

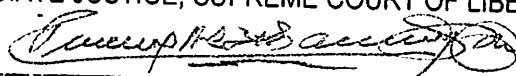

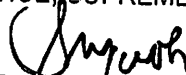
